

Furniture care instruction for SOLID WOOD Furniture

- Wood expands and contracts with the variations in temperature and humidity, Expect each piece of solid wood furniture to react differently depending on the type of species of wood used, it exhibits the real solid wood properties. Any crack/knot occuring due to expansion & contraction can be filled with wood filler.
- Avoid exposing wood furniture to continuous direct sunlight to avoid fading and other damages like cracking, fibre rupture and to show visible glue line
- Gently open & close the doors, lids & drawers.
- When moving a piece of furniture, do not drag it, move it from its strongest part.
- 5. Beware of water from spills and condensation on drink glasses that can cause damage to coatings.
- 6. Do not place hot items on any surface as it may stain the surface.
- 7. Dust can be abrasive, always clean with a soft dry cloth.
- 8. Use a soft cloth and wipe with the grain, a furniture polish may be applied if a little more shine is desired.
- Do not allow pets on furniture, as they can be extremely abrasive to furnishings
- Lift and place items instead of sliding across furniture surfaces.
- 11. Certain growing regions have a high concentration of calcium, sulphur, and other trace minerals in the soil or in the water table. These minerals are drawn up through the roots and deposited into the pore structure and heart of the tree. Once the timber is cut, mineral deposits can show up as chalky white lines and dots in the pores of the boards.
- 12. Recommend to refresh your product once or twice a year to maintain look of product through refreshing kit.
- 13. Use of coasters & mats is recommended for placing hot utensils.
